How does Coffee County Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards, secured files and buildings.
How does Coffee County Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account or deposit money Pay your bills or apply for a loan Use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from credit bureaus, affiliates, and other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only -Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness - Affiliates from using your information to market to you -Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
